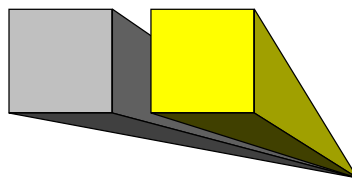

Who we are, what we do

Founded in 1961, CLCCR is the European liaison committee of a number of national associations of the body and trailer building industries.

CLCCR's objective is to promote, defend and represent the general interests of the European body and trailer industries, especially within the European Union and the United Nations. CLCCR seeks to co-ordinate the opinions and interests of its member associations and companies in both technical and economic terms. It aims at harmonious and continual development of international trade, particularly through the elimination of technical barriers to trade.

CLCCR represents almost 1,000 European trailer and body builders and more than 50 bus and coach builders. The members of CLCCR altogether employ about 100,000 people, whose annual turnover amounts to € 15 billion. On average, more than three quarters of all trailers registered in the European Union are built by CLCCR member companies.

CLCCR structure

The members of CLCCR elect from amongst their members the President, Vice-President and Secretary General at the plenary meeting. The President of CLCCR is elected for a period of two years and is normally succeeded in the next period in office by the current Vice-President. Both must be representatives from member companies of the national associations. The current President, Vice-President and Secretaries of CLCCR are:

CLCCR's areas of activity

Delegates from the national associations together with member companies meet twice a year at a plenary meeting to discuss and decide about political and economic issues. Statistical data is gathered from national associations and made available to CLCCR's members free of charge. The special technical interests of the individual members are safeguarded by CLCCR's Technical Committee (TC) and its working groups. There are working groups on Braking, ADR (transport of dangerous goods), TIR (transport under customs seal), ATP (transport of perishable foodstuffs) and a Bus & Coach working group.

CLCCR actively participates in a number of technical working groups of the European Commission and in the working groups GRRF, GRSG, ADR, TIR and ATP of the United Nations in Geneva.

CLCCR's working language is English.
