EUROPEAN GLASS INDUSTRIES

In order to provide a comprehensive and analytical overview of the situation in the glass industry, this report provides statistics for the whole glass industry together and statistics for each of the glass sectors. The situation varies a lot between the different sectors.

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I. Introduction – Comments

Industry Overview

Since 2022, the European glass industry struggles with enormous difficulties to survive and ended 2025 with mitigated results in the different glass sub-sectors.

The glass market in 2025 saw minimal advancement and continues to move at a slow pace in early 2026. Despite significant technological progress and heavy investments in zero-emission initiatives, the European glass industry is facing several challenges. These include high energy costs, the repercussions of the conflict in Ukraine, stiff competition from non-EU countries, including the chaotic business relations with the USA since January 2025 and their strong economic measures, and accelerating imports from Asia.

These challenging conditions are casting a shadow over the future of the glass industry in Europe, leading to plant closures and a decline in employment opportunities.

All in all, there is still no sign of any improvement in the economic situation since alarming signals highlighted already in 2023 to national and European authorities.

Key figures 2025 in tonnes, compared to 2024, include:

- **Overall glass production** remaining stable in 2025, with **37.5 million tonnes**,
- **EU imports** continuing to increase by 4.7%, while **EU exports** stagnate with a slight increase of 0.5%.

Despite these mean results, the **European production levels** continue to rank among the world's largest glass producers alongside China and North America. Germany leads the EU as the top producer, followed closely by Italy, Turkey, France, Spain, Poland, and the UK.

Looking at the various sub-sectors within the glass industry, 2025 saw a globally stable level of production compared with 2024, with however differences between sub-sectors:

- Flat glass: - 4.76%
- Container glass: + 1.45%
- Mineral Wool insulation: + 2.96%
- Continuous Filament glass fibres: - 2.6%
- Domestic glassware: - 3.6%
- Other glasses (incl. special glass): - 20.7%

Regarding **foreign trade**, imports from Asian countries, particularly China, remain significant.

In 2025, extra EU-27 **exports slightly increased by 0.5% in volume** (3.52 million tonnes) but decreased **by 2.8% in value** (8.4 billion Euros) compared to 2024. The EU-27's four major export destinations include the rest of Europe (68%), with UK (23%), Switzerland (12%), Turkey (7.5%), Serbia (5%) and Ukraine (7%), followed by the USA (9.3%), North Africa (5.5%) and Far East Asia (4.3%).

On the **import side**, there was however a **5.5% increase in volume** (5.27 million tonnes) and a **0.1% increase in value** (8.4 billion euros) for extra-EU27 imports in 2025 compared to the previous year. Far-East Asia accounted for 42% of EU imports (*including 35% from China alone*), the rest of Europe for 41% (*including UK (10%), Turkey (12%), Switzerland (7%)*), and North Africa for 7.5%.

The glass industry is increasingly exposed to unfair trade practices. In response, the European Commission has recently imposed anti-dumping measures on glass fibre yarns originating from China, reviewed the level of existing measures on glass fibre reinforcements from China, and extended measures to imports from third countries where Chinese producers have established production facilities, notably Egypt, Bahrain and Thailand.

Employment 2025

Employment in the industry has been gradually declining since 2019. In 2025, the number of employees remained stable compared to 2024, totalling 128.500 direct employees.

Outlook

The European glass industry stands at a critical crossroads. Challenges facing the sector have intensified in recent years, driven by persistently high energy and production costs, increasing investment requirements for the renewal, modernisation and regulatory compliance of industrial assets, and growing distortions in global markets. In addition, in certain glass subsector, global non-market overcapacities and unfairly priced imports continue to create an uneven competitive landscape. Disparities in regulatory, environmental and operating costs between regions are increasing and further alter the ability of European glass manufacturers to invest, innovate and grow.

At the same time, glass remains a strategic material for Europe's green and digital transitions, economic security, strategic autonomy and defence objectives. As a versatile and infinitely recyclable material, glass is a foundational component of our economy and critical value chains. Glass products are essential for many applications, including the food and beverage sector, the pharmaceutical, perfumery and cosmetics sectors, energy-efficient and comfortable living and working spaces, sustainable mobility, infrastructure, digitalisation, medical and pharmaceutical devices, renewable energy technologies, electronics and appliances, jewellery, perfumery and other luxury goods, among many others that support Europe's competitiveness, resilience and quality of life.

Despite this increasingly challenging landscape, European glass manufacturers strive to continue driving innovation, advancing circularity and decarbonisation. Companies are developing new products and applications, increasing the use of recycled materials, and deploying technologies and practices that reduce emissions while improving energy efficiency and industrial performance. The sector remains fully committed to contributing to the EU's climate objectives and to building a more sustainable industrial future. To sustain this transformation and unlock the required investments, however, it must be supported by a policy framework that restores a solid business case, ensures fair competition and addresses structural cost disadvantages.

Europe needs its glass industry, and the glass industry needs a supportive business environment in Europe. Preserving this industrial capacity will require renewed political attention to its competitiveness.

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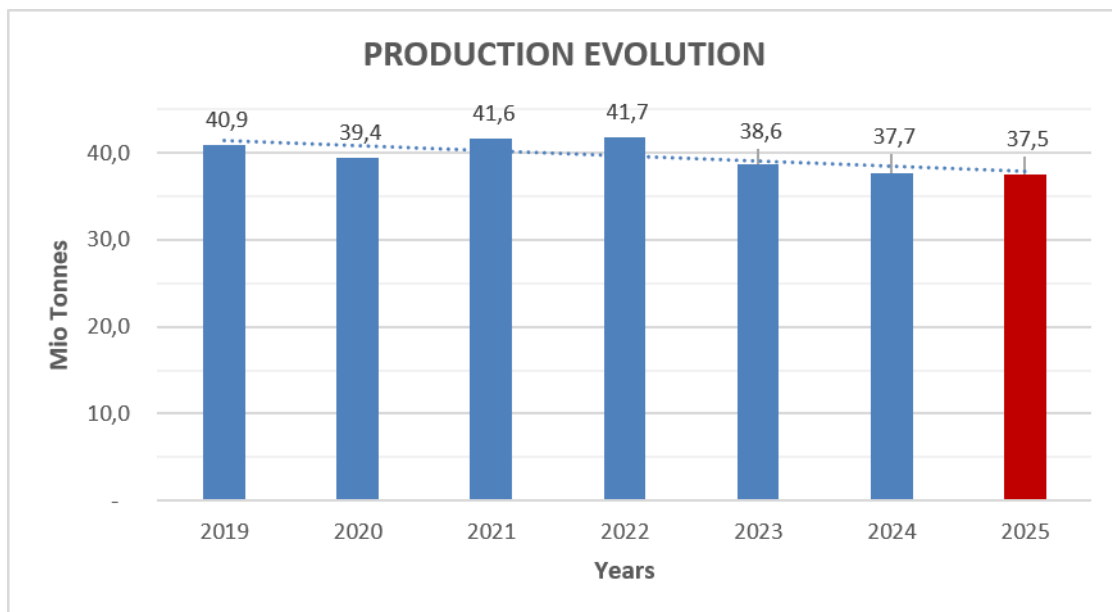

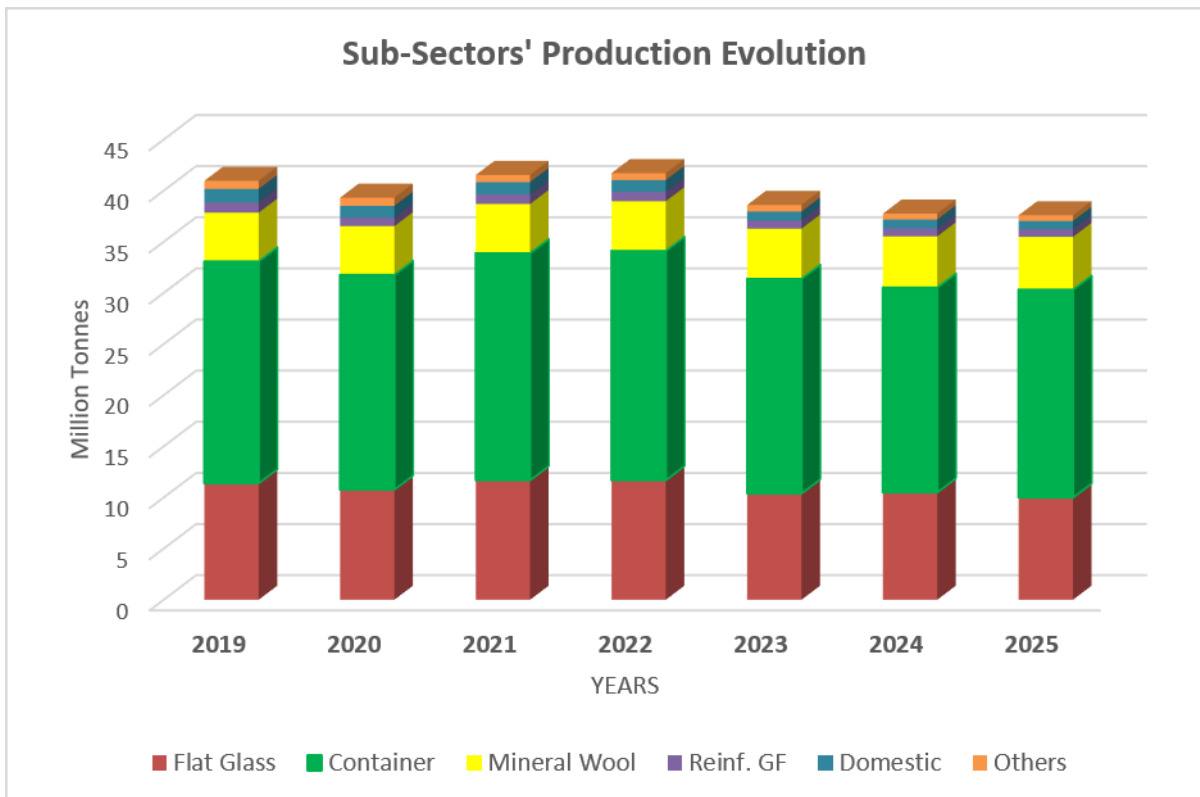
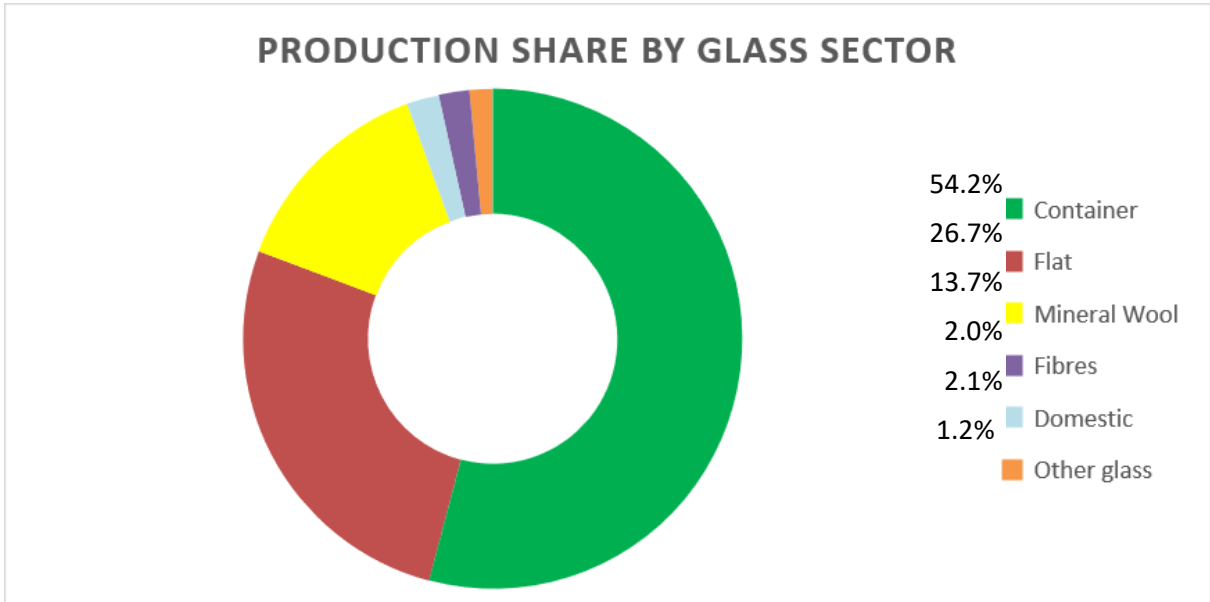
Reported production by sectors refers to saleable glass, except for the flat glass sector where production expresses the tonnage of melted glass.

The production rate of GAE membership remains rather stable in 2025 compared with 2024, with a slight drop for most sub-sectors, except container glass and insulating glass fibres.

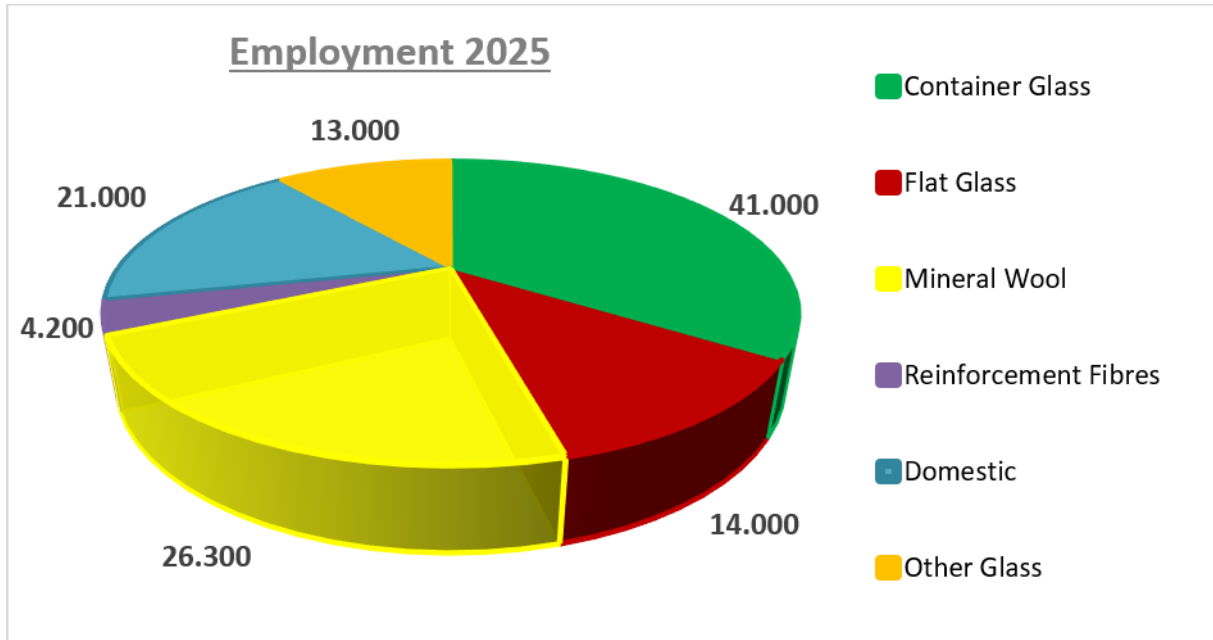
Compared to 2019 index (100), sectoral production reached index 87.7 for flat glass, 93.8 for container glass, 60.4 for tableware and crystal, 75.6 for continuous filament glass fibres, 108.5 for mineral wool insulation, and 57.2 for other glasses.

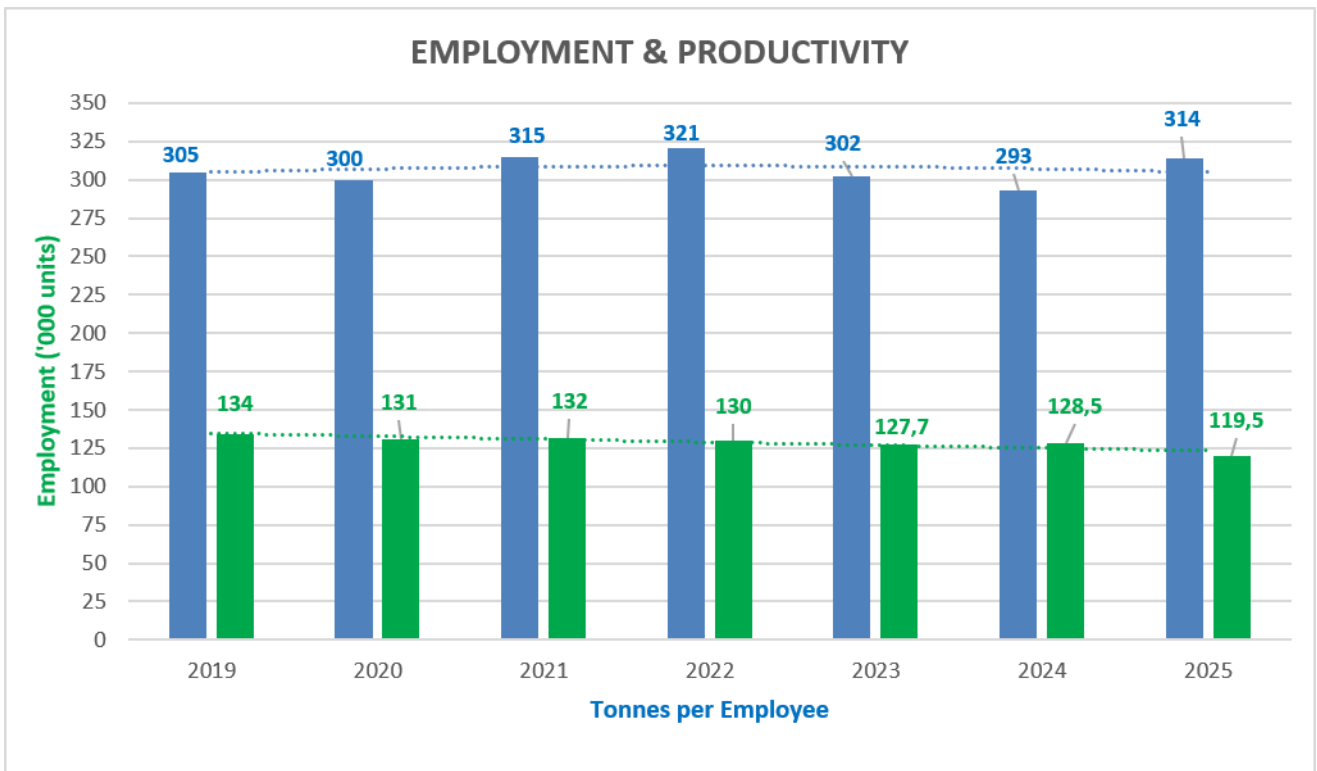

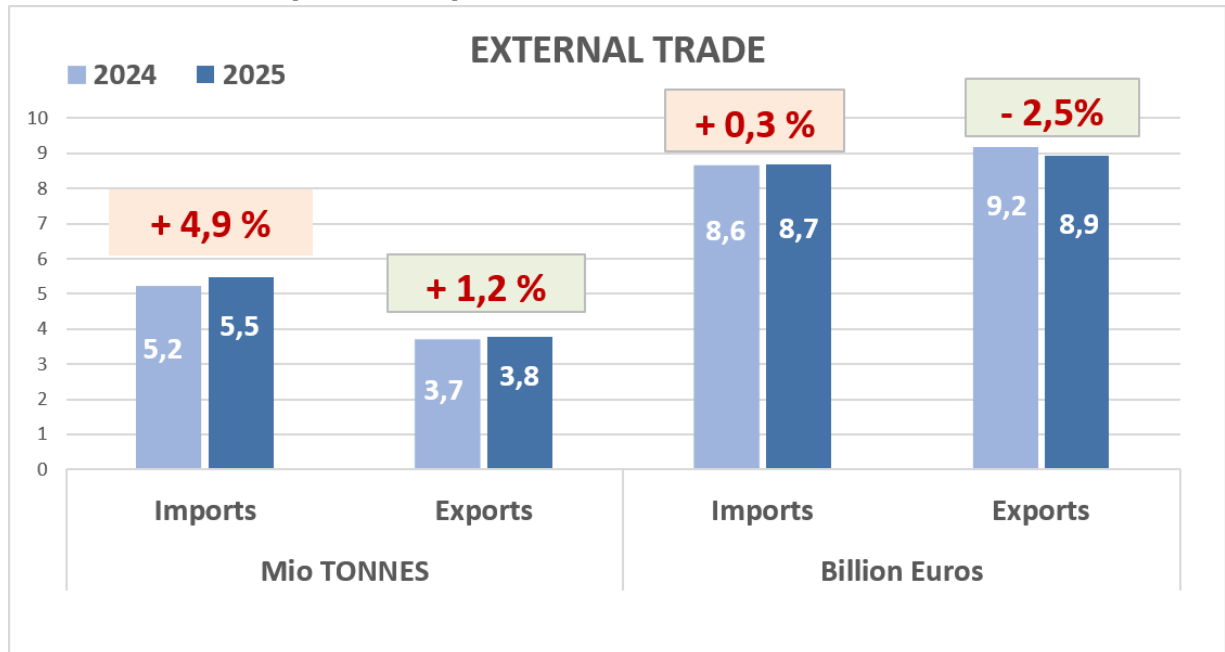
