EU Companies across strategic industrial value chains are invited to join
a Global Gateway Investment Mission to Guyana,
alongside with the Caribbean Shipping Association Conference
26-30 October 2026 | Georgetown, Guyana

The **Delegation of the European Union to Guyana, Suriname and CARICOM**, in coordination with the **Embassy and Trade Council of Sweden** and under the **Team Europe** framework, invites EU companies to participate in an Inbound Global Gateway Investment Mission to Guyana, to be held from 28 to 30 October 2026 in Georgetown, Guyana.

The mission is designed for EU companies active across strategic industrial sectors that can support Guyana's economic development and infrastructure expansion, including **healthcare, pharma and life sciences, energy, transport and logistics, infrastructure and construction, maritime industries, telecommunications and digital connectivity, security and resilience solutions**, as well as **industrial technologies and advanced manufacturing**. The programme will facilitate targeted business-to-business and business-to-government engagements, providing participants with opportunities to explore partnerships, investment prospects, procurement opportunities, and emerging projects across Guyana and the wider Caribbean region.

In addition, this mission is organised back-to-back with **the Caribbean Shipping Association (CSA) Annual Conference** (26–27 October 2026), offering EU companies an excellent opportunity to engage with Caribbean partners on the future of **maritime transport, smart ports, sustainable logistics, and supply chain resilience**.

CONTEXT AND RATIONALE

Guyana is one of the world's fastest-growing economies, driven by offshore oil and gas but also committed to economic diversification, infrastructure modernisation, and sustainable development. The country's strategic location, public investment agenda, and ambitions to become a **regional logistics, energy, and connectivity hub** create significant opportunities for European companies in sectors such as:

- **Transport, ports, and logistics**
- **Energy and renewables**

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- **Telecommunications and digital infrastructure**
- **Healthcare systems and technologies**
- **Sustainable infrastructure and urban development**
- **Security and critical infrastructure resilience**

MISSION OBJECTIVES

- Showcase European expertise and solutions in sustainable technologies, infrastructure, and services.
- Facilitate dialogue with Guyanese ministries, public authorities, and private sector stakeholders.
- Support B2B and B2G matchmaking to identify partnership and investment opportunities.
- Position EU companies as long-term partners in Guyana's economic transformation.

LOGISTICS AND COSTS

The delegation will be based in the Georgetown metropolitan area, Guyana's political, economic, and commercial center. Activities will be conducted at relevant government ministries, business and innovation hubs, industry venues, and conference facilities, complemented by targeted field visits to strategic projects and partner organizations.

Mission costs: Participating companies will be responsible for their own travel, accommodation, and conference registration fees.

The Delegation of the European Union to Guyana, Suriname and CARICOM, and the **Swedish Embassy and Trade Council** will facilitate stakeholder engagement, meetings, and field visits.

The EU-funded Technical Assistance **Global Gateway Investment Agenda (GGIA) for Guyana and Suriname** will cover the costs of the venue and catering services for 2-days business forum sessions (28-29 Oct.), and local transport to Government facilities for B2Gs and field visits.
