**Subject: AS743 Anti-subsidy investigation concerning imports of new pneumatic  
tyres, of rubber, of a kind used on motor cars, buses or lorries with a  
load index not exceeding 121 originating in the People's Republic of  
China**

**Non-imposition of provisional measures**

On 6 November 2025, the European Commission initiated an anti-subsidy proceeding concerning imports of passenger car and light lorry tyres originating in the People's Republic of China. The proceeding was initiated under Article 10 of Regulation (EU) 2016/1037 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2016 on protection against subsidised imports from countries not members of the European Union.

Given the technical complexity of the case, the Commission has decided not to impose provisional measures and to continue the investigation.
