

# CORONAVIRUS

## 3G Obligation to Produce Proof of Covid Status at the Workplace\*

According to the 3rd COVID Measures Regulation, you must be able to produce proof of one of the following for the entire time you are at the workplace:

### → Vaccinated

Single-shot vaccine (Johnson & Johnson)	<b>from 22 days</b> after vaccination <b>up to 270 days</b> after vaccination
Two-shot vaccine (Moderna, BioNTech/Pfizer, AstraZeneca)	from the <b>2nd dose of vaccine</b> <b>up to 360 days</b> after two-shot vaccination**
Single-shot vaccine after recovery or evidence of neutralising antibodies	from <b>vaccine</b> <b>up to 360 days</b> after vaccination**
Booster vaccine	<b>up to 360 days</b> after 3rd dose**

### → Recovered

Medical confirmation of recovery from Covid-19 infection or proof of recovery or isolation note	<b>up to 180 days</b> after recovery from infection

### → Tested

PCR test	<b>up to 72 hours</b> after testing
Antigen test by an official body	<b>up to 24 hours</b> after testing

\* Stricter rules apply for employees working in night clubs and bars, and at large-scale events (starting at 250 attendees), among others

\*\* from 6 December onwards: only valid 270 days after vaccination
