

Importance of International Trade for Austria:

EUR 141,9 bn exports of goods **2017 (+8,2%)**
EUR 147,6 bn imports of goods **2017 (+8,8%)**

EUR 58,8 bn exports of services **2017 (+6,3%)**
EUR 48,4 bn imports of services **2017 (+9,4%)**

58,000 exporters:

Around 10% of all Austrian companies have international business activities.

In Austria, **every second job** is directly or indirectly dependent on exports

Austria's committed exporters create employment and economic growth.

54 % export ratio (goods and services):

International trade is Austria's primary source of wealth creation and one of the main pillars of its economy and society.

USD 19,200 export per capita:

Austria is one of the world's biggest per capita exporters and is the 7th largest exporter of goods per capita.

EUR 201,1 bn (stock) Austrian foreign direct investment abroad, employing **811,753 people** outside of Austria (2015)

Austria is a key investor in Central, Eastern and South-Eastern Europe:
It is the top foreign investor in three countries (Slovenia, Croatia and Bosnia-Herzegovina).

EUR 155,00 bn (stock) inward foreign direct investment, employing **263,399 people** in Austria (2015)
