The apprenticeship

is the most popular form of education and training in Austria.

It gives you a practical – and practice-based – recognised professional education. It helps you make a successful start to your professional life.

The apprenticeship lays the foundation for an excellent career and also enables other forms of further education, such as a high school leaving certificate or degree studies.


There are currently around 160 apprenticeship professions and 5,000 companies offering apprenticeships in Styria. Opportunities range from motor vehicle technology to carpentry, cooking to retail, electrical engineering to hairdressing and office roles – there's something for everyone.

An apprenticeship lasts from two to four years. During that time, you're already earning your own money. At the end of your apprenticeship, you will sit the final apprenticeship examination, for which you will also receive a state examination certificate.
