


New position paper for a Waste Shipment Regulation benefiting plastics circularity

The Commission's proposal for a Waste Shipment Regulation (WSR) responds to the call in the European Green Deal and the Circular Economy Action Plan to revise the WSR in order to (1) facilitate shipments of waste for re-use and recycling in the EU, (2) ensure that the EU does not export its waste challenges to third countries and (3) tackle illegal shipments of waste. In view of the start of the trialogue negotiations, EuRIC recalls the key messages for achieving plastics circularity and free trade in the EU.

EuRIC participated in Basel Convention COP-16

EuRIC, together with <u>BMRA</u> and <u>BIR</u>, attended the Sixteenth Meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the <u>Basel Convention</u>, which was held in Geneva from 1-12 May. <u>Important topics for the recycling industry were discussed and adopted, such as the Technical Guidance on Plastic Waste and POPs Waste. Other important issues such as the revision of Annexes I, III and IV of the Basel Convention were also addressed, but it was decided that more work is needed to reach a decision.</u>



EuRIC participated in the annual networking event of Gremi de Recuperació

EuRIC participated in the annual networking event organized by our partner **Gremi de Recuperació de Catalunya**, on the occasion of its 70th anniversary. The event took place on 4-5 May 2023. **Maria Vera and Alejandro Navazas introduced the EU legislative changes affecting the waste management and recycling sector.**

"Europe needs to step up circular economy efforts" states the European Environment Agency

The EU's circular economy action plan aims to double the share of recycled materials used in its economy by 2030. The European Environment Agency's (EEA) assessment, published on 17 May, shows that the pace of progress needs speeding up, requiring both more recycling and less overall material use. A second, in-depth report on waste prevention highlights opportunities for stronger and systemic approach for monitoring progress at EU level.

On 15 May, the EU's statistics office, Eurostat, published its **revision of the EU circular economy monitoring framework**, changing how the Commission tracks progress made in the green transition. It has **added several new criteria** including material and consumption footprint and resource productivity.
