

Faster group check-in thanks to change in Austrian registration law

Due to a change in Austrian registration law, the process of checking tour groups into hotels has been speeded up considerably since late July 2017. It is no longer necessary for each individual group member to state his/her data; registration can be done collectively for the entire group. Group check-in times are thus reduced considerably.

Here's the most important information in brief:

The individual members of tour groups are no longer subject to obligatory individual registration if the tour escort/group leader/coach driver completes the guest registration form of the hotel with his/her full data and presents a list of all tour group members, stating names and citizenship; for non-Austrian tour group members, the list also has to include the type, number and issuing authority of the respective travel documents. This list has to be handed over at the reception desk on arrival.

This method applies on condition that the tour group does not stay in the same accommodation as a group for more than two weeks.
